Meeting Minutes
November 6, 2006

The PTA meeting was called to order by Jennifer Morgan, President at 7:16 pm in the teachers lounge on Monday, November 6, 2006.

Kelly had a presentation showing the current condition of the playgrounds and ways to improve them – requested money from the PTA to purchase new equipment and make the playgrounds safer. This was put on hold until Barbara Villafana can speak with the District and find out what they are willing to contribute. A few minor improvements are being done through the district.

Membership is up from last year even with the drop in students. Red Ribbon week was successfully done by Ruth Cook.

Mrs. Comitz went over her calendar. The Datawise Star Testing will show who needs intervention. November 13th will be Title I parent meeting and Student Success for Kindergarten. November 14th will be Student Success for 1st and 2nd Grade.
