Principal's Message

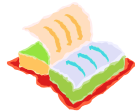
Kindergarten Registration

Measure 'A'

As you know, the Wiseburn School District has been engaging in a complete renewal of the school facilities at our district schools. The new Juan de Anza School, completed in 2002, represented one phase of this plan. The remodeling of Peter Burnett School has been completed and the construction of the new Dana Middle School will be completed in the Fall of 2007.

We are very excited about these new facilities and the educational benefits for ALL our students. Unfortunately, due to an unprecedented rise in worldwide costs for raw materials for construction, there are not presently enough funds to complete the final school: a new Cabrillo Elementary School.

In order to provide ALL students with the same high quality education, our Wiseburn School Board of Trustees has placed Measure "A" on the June 12th ballot to rebuild Cabrillo Elementary. We encourage all Wiseburn residents to become familiar with the facts related to this election and participate in the election on June 12th.
