Principal's Message

Cabrillo teachers have been very busy assessing your children's academic and social growth and are looking forward to conferencing with each parent or guardian. We are making this fall conference mandatory so please make arrangements to take some time off to conference with your child's teacher. It is imperative that we all work as a team in ensuring the best education possible for our Cabrillo children.

This is the third year that we are using a standards-based report card in Wiseburn School District. They will be distributed on Friday, December 9. The parent-teacher conference period is scheduled for December 12th through December 23rd. If your child receives Title One services, you will receive a Continuum, specific to his/her skills. If your child is in the English Learner Program, you will receive an ELD report card.

TRY TO MAKE THE MOST OF YOUR PARENT-TEACHER CONFERENCE

1. Talk to your child and ask what they think is their best/worst subject and why. Discuss this with the teacher.
2. Write down your questions and ask such things as:
 - How is my child doing in each curricular area?
 - Does my child participate in class discussions and activities?
 - Is my child working up to his/her ability?
 - How well does my child get along with others?
 - Is she/he handing in homework?
 - How can I help at home?
3. Share with the teacher things about your child that the teacher needs to know. This will make it easier to meet your child's needs.

4. Ask for help in interpreting the progress report and get the teacher's views on needed improvements.

5. Arrive for your conference on time. Teachers have many conferences and even a five-minute delay can throw off their schedule. If you have to postpone the meeting, please do so in a timely manner. Your time is valuable and so is the teacher's.

Holiday Festivities

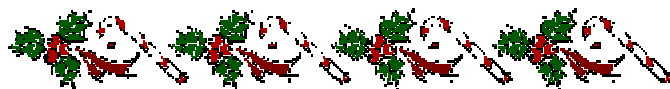
